Dry Moorage Privileges

Hueston Sailing Association has an agreement with Hueston Woods State Park that we can use their dry moorage lot near the marina as long as each member using the lot participates in two Public Programs such as Sailing Experiences, Intro to Sail events, or other volunteer activities. To store a boat in the lot you must be an active regular member and abide by club and park rules. Note: If using the dry moorage lot, supporting two Public Program events is in addition to the two race committee duty dates members must also fulfill.
