Elephants & Sailboats

Well, the Exec Team didn’t *forget* what you’ve said these last few seasons. At its January planning session, it addressed the elephant in the room. The rumors you may have *heard* are true. This is not a weird pink elephant dream … HSA is going to trial a fourth start on Sunday afternoons! It’ll be: 1. Catamarans, 2. Y-Fliers, 3. Sunfish & Capri 14s, and lastly, 4. Handicappers.

After much discussion about supporting our ever-increasing cruiser fleet while giving our strong Sunfish/Capri fleet fewer elephants to dodge, this scheme seemed like a good two-fer. The handicaps of the Capri and Sunfish are very similar (D-PN 99.4 & 99.6) so they will be rank-order finished. Boats with big elephant ears will get handicapped.



One Day Course Retired: In other Exec Team news, Brett Hart has run the numbers and successfully made the argument that our one-day introductory courses were not bringing in new members *while heavily taxing our volunteer cadre*. The three-day courses however generated much higher “join rate” numbers. So, this year HSA will only offer three-day sailing courses *and* limit the number of students to a more sustainable volunteer workload. New students wanting a one-day experience can still visit us on ODNR Sail Experience days. Those May and September events are free and thanks to the continued generosity of the Visitors Bureau will still include picnic food. Hopefully, the opportunity to see sailboats up close and talk to our friendly members will inspire them to take our three-day course. Well done, Brett!
